RESOLUTION # 240-98
WATER RATE RAISE

WHEREAS: IT IS REQUIRED THAT THE WATER RATES BE RAISED TO COVER THE RISING COST OF EXPENSES.

WHEREAS: IT HAS BEEN PASSED UNANIMOUSLY BY THE TOWN COUNCIL AT THE REGULAR MEETING HELD AT CITY HALL AUGUST 10, 1998.

NOW THEREFORE: IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FARMINGTON, WHITMAN COUNTY, WASHINGTON AS FOLLOWS:

The Residential Water Rates be raised by \$2.00 from \$14.50 to \$16.50. The usage will stay the same at 700⁰⁰⁰ cubic feet or 7500 5250 gallons flat rate, and \$.75 for each 500 cubic feet or 3750 gallons thereafter. *amended by Council 9-14-98*

Stand-by will remain at \$10.00 per month/Reconnection fee \$100.

The new rates will go into effect September 1, 1998, with the first collection on that date.

This Resolution #240-98 was passed on August 10, 1998 and signed into effect on August 13, 1998.
