

**TOWN OF FARMINGTON
RESOLUTION #270-04
WATER/SEWER RATE RAISE**

WHEREAS: It is required that the water and sewer rates be raised to cover the cost of rising expenses.

WHEREAS: It has been passed unanimously by the Town Council at the regular meeting held at City Hall February 9, 2004.

NOW THEREFORE: IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FARMINGTON, WHITMAN COUNTY, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:

The residential water rated by raised by \$4.00 from \$19.50 to \$23.50 per 1000 cubic feet or 7500 gallons flat rate and \$.75 for each 500 cubic feet or 3750 gallons thereafter.

The stand-by rates will therefore be raised by the same amount as residential. Therefore, the rate will be \$17.00 up \$4.00 from the old rate of \$13.00, for a meter showing no use and deemed to be on stand-by.

The commercial rates will go up accordingly from \$34.00 to \$37.00 flat rate.

The sewer rates will remain unchanged at this time. It will continue at \$21.50 per month flat rate.

THE NEW RATES WILL GO INTO EFFECT FEBRUARY 9, 2004 WITH THE FIRST COLLECTION DUE ON MARCH 1, 2004.

THIS RESOLUTION #270-04 WAS PASSED AND SIGNED INTO EFFECT ON THIS DATE FEBRUARY 9, 2004.
