

**TOWN OF FARMINGTON  
RESOLUTION #283-05  
RCW 84.55.120**

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Farmington has met and considered its budget for the calendar year 2006; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Farmington after hearing and duly considering all relevant evidence and testimony presented, determined that the Town of Farmington requires a regular levy in the amount of \$13,595.00, Which includes an increase in property tax revenue from the previous year of 0%, and amounts resulting from the addition of new construction and improvements to property and any increase in the value of state-assessed property, and amounts authorized by law as a result of any annexations that have occurred and refunds made, in order to discharge the expected expenses and obligations of the district and it its best interest; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Farmington that an increase in the regular property tax levy is hereby authorized for the 2006 levy in the amount of \$13,000, which is a percentage increase of 0% from the previous year.

This increase is exclusive of additional revenue resulting from the addition of new construction and improvements to property and any increase in the value of state assessed property, and any additional amounts resulting from any annexations that have occurred and refunds made.
