

**TOWN OF FARMINGTON
RESOLUTION # 292-07**

CALLING FOR ELECTION ON EXCESS LEVY PROPOSITIONS

WHEREAS: The TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FARMINGTON has determined that the Regular Levy for the TOWN OF FARMINGTON for the year 2008, will be insufficient to meet the ordinary and necessary operating expenses the TOWN expects to incur, especially in the Current Expense Fund and City Street Maintenance Fund.

WHEREAS: The TOWN COUNCIL has determined that the most expedient means of generating additional Revenue for the year 2008, is to initiate an Excess Tax Levy.

NOW THEREFORE: It is hereby resolved by the MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FARMINGTON, WHITMAN COUNTY, WASHINGTON, as follows:

1. That a SPECIAL ELECTION shall be had and held on or about November 6, 2007, at the regular polling place within the COUNTY.
2. That the Clerk-Treasurer present the necessary Ballot Titles to the WHITMAN COUNTY AUDITOR within the required time by Law for said AUDITOR'S review and approval.
3. The content of the proposed Ballot Titles for the aforementioned Special Levies be substantially as follows:

PROPOSITION #1

SHALL THE TOWN OF FARMINGTON LEVY A SPECIAL TAX OF \$10,000. AN ESTIMATED \$. PER \$1,000 OF THE 2008 ASSESSED VALUATION, FOR CURRENT EXPENSE FUND, FOR COLLECTION IN 2008, BE APPROVED?

PROPOSITION #2

SHALL THE TOWN OF FARMINGTON LEVY A SPECIAL TAX OF \$8,000. AN ESTIMATED \$. PER \$1,000 OF 2008 ASSESSED VALUATION, FOR STREET MAINTENANCE, FOR COLLECTION IN 2008 BE APPROVED?

4. That the SPECIAL LEVY ELECTION be held, if possible, with the GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN November 2007, and that the TOWN pay the proportionate costs of its SPECIAL ELECTION.

5. That such LEVY ELECTION be held in the manner and form provided by Law.
