Resolution 357-13

36.4% Property Tax Allocation to Street Fund**

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FARMINGTON, WASHINGTON authorizing the direct receipt of a portion of the general property tax levy into the Street Fund (101).

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Farmington sees the need to receipt 36.4% of the general levy into the Street Fund where it can be appropriated for regular maintenance of town streets, administrative duties of public works, street lighting, snow and ice control, and all other functions within said fund.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Farmington may, by resolution, change the percentage amount of the general levy to be receipted directly to the Street Fund.

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED THAT THE TOWN COUNCIL FOR THE TOWN OF FARMINGTON, WASHINGTON does hereby authorize the receipt of 36.4% of the general levy directly into the Street Fund (101).
