RESOLUTION # 363-14

CALLING FOR ELECTION ON EXCESS LEVY PROPOSITIONS

WHEREAS: The TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FARMINGTON has determined that the Regular Levy for the TOWN OF FARMINGTON for the year 2015, will be insufficient to meet the ordinary and necessary operating expenses the TOWN expects to incur, especially in the Current Expense Fund and City Street Maintenance Fund.

WHEREAS: The TOWN COUNCIL has determined that the most expedient means of generating additional Revenue for the year 2015, is to initiate an Excess Tax Levy.

NOW THEREFORE: It is hereby resolved by the MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF FARMINGTON, WHITMAN COUNTY, WASHINGTON, as follows:

1. That the GENERAL ELECTION shall be held on November 4th, 2014.
2. That the Clerk-Treasurer presents the necessary Ballot Titles to the WHITMAN COUNTY AUDITOR within the required time by Law.
3. The content of the proposed Ballot Titles for the aforementioned Special Levies be substantially as follows:

PROPOSITION #1

SHALL THE TOWN OF FARMINGTON LEVY A SPECIAL TAX OF \$ 9,000.00 AN ESTIMATED \$ 0.84 PER \$1,000 OF THE 2014 ASSESSED VALUATION, FOR CITY STREET MAINTENANCE FUND, FOR COLLECTION IN 2015, BE APPROVED?


PROPOSITION #2

4. That such LEVY ELECTION be held in the manner and form provided by Law.




